Well, don't keep them hidden away too long.**

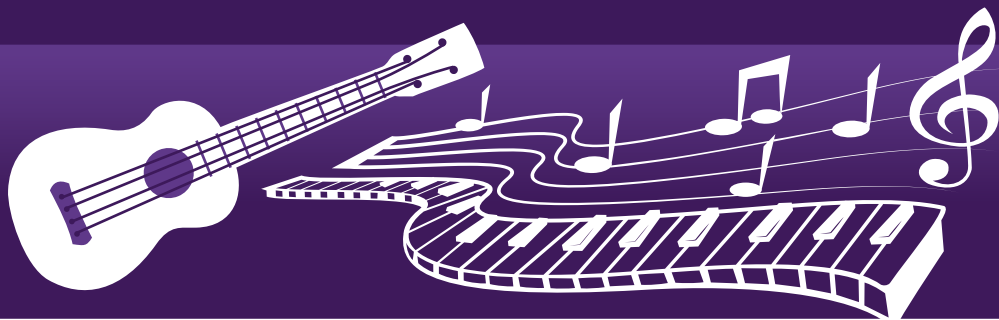
Latrobe Music is a community organisation bringing exciting music workshops to the Gippsland Region.

If you would like to learn the Ukulele – look no further! Latrobe Music is now offering one-on-one ukulele lessons in Traralgon.
